## Annual Listing of Obligated Projects

### Fiscal Year 2022

#### **Purpose**

The purpose of this report is to provide a list of federal highway and transit funded projects obligated in the previous fiscal year. A project is considered obligated when a funding contract has been completed, or a grant has been awarded. The report includes all projects in the Shoals Urban Area obligated in fiscal year 2022, which ran from October 1, 2021 through September 30, 2022. Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) are required to produce this list annually.

#### **Laws and Regulations**

The laws that govern Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) are found in Section 134 of Title 23 of the United States Code and Section 5303 of Title 49 of the United States Code. The Code was superseded or amended by the *Fixing America's Surface Transportation Act (FAST Act)* Section 1201, December 2015. The rules that govern metropolitan planning organizations are published in the Code of Federal Regulations (CFRs) as Title 23, Chapter 1, Part 450, Subpart C. Section 450.334 specifically relates to the development of the annual listing of obligated projects.

#### **Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)**

The list of obligated projects begins with the Transportation Improvement Program (TIP). Federally funded projects must be included in the TIP. The TIP is a prioritized list of transportation projects adopted every four years by the MPO. The projects on the TIP are taken from the Shoals Area Long-Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) except for certain level-of-effort projects. The LRTP covers a 25-year horizon, while the TIP covers only four years. The TIP divides the LRTP into four different phases (preliminary engineering, right-of-way, utility relocation, and construction) and assigns a start date to each phase of the project.

#### **Summary of Obligated Projects**

A total of \$40,558,799 million was obligated during fiscal year 2022 for a variety of State, County, and local roadway projects in the Shoals Urban Area.

This includes \$2,300,984 in FTA for transit operations.

**Table Format**

The table is sorted by project Sponsor. The Project Number refers to the Alabama Department of Transportation project management identification code. The scope represents the phase of the project. Road projects are divided into preliminary engineering (PE), right-of-way (RW), utility relocation (UT), and construction (CN). The description starts with the type of work, followed by the name of the road. The Alabama Department of Transportation provided the project listing through their online portal program.

The amounts listed in the “% Engineers Estimate” identifies the estimated federal funding amount. The “Fed. Obligated” column shows how much funding has been committed at the time the report was ran. The “Fed. Expenditure” column represent what has been spent on the project. The “Balance” numbers are the amounts that have not been used.
