This grant funding will provide financial assistance for public transportation service for the residents of Colbert, Franklin, Lauderdale, Marion, and Winston Counties.

The service operates Monday through Friday, 7 am to 5 pm. All residents must schedule service by 3:00 p.m. the previous business day. Fares for one-way trips are \$3.00 up to 1.5 miles outside the city limits; \$6.00 1.5 – 5 miles outside the city limits; \$9.00 6 – 10 miles outside the city limits and \$9.00 plus \$2.00 per additional mile beyond 10 miles outside the city limits.

This Capital funding will be used to purchase 1 Service Truck.

Fare Structure

- Rides within The Shoals city limits = \$6.00 per one way trip
 - Rides 1.5 miles – 5 miles outside city limits = \$12.00 per one way trip
 - Rides 6 miles – 10 miles outside city limits = \$18.00 per one way trip
- *All rides further than 10 miles past the city limits will be based on \$18.00 + \$4.00 per additional mile and availability of time.

Drivers are not able to make change.
