#### **SERVICE DEFINITIONS**

# **Unskilled Respite**

Services that offer temporary, substitute support of the Care Recipient to provide a brief period of relief or rest to the Caregiver. Services included: Personal Care, Homemaker, and Respite Services.

## **Skilled Respite**

Services that offer temporary, substitute support of the Care Recipient to provide a brief period of relief or rest to the Caregiver. Skilled Respite Service provides skilled medical observation and services that are to be performed by a Registered Nurse or a Licensed Practical Nurse.

### **Caregiver Case Management**

Case Management is an assessment of the client's situation to be rendered by the contractor after services have been provided for the client for a second time by same service contractor.
